Application Standards for the Road Safety Education Program – Operating a Moped or Motorized Scooter¹

The driving course lasts a minimum of 6 hours and consists of the following:

- 3 hours of theoretical instruction;
- 3 hours of practical training on a closed circuit track, the final 30 minutes of which are devoted to evaluating the learner;
- Home study outside of the driving school².

Theoretical instruction must be completed before practical training can begin.

Home study:

Before beginning the driving course, the learner is required to study information provided in the guide entitled *Operating a Moped or Scooter* and the *Driver's Handbook* to learn about traffic rules, road signs and traffic signals. Information in these study guides ties in with the driving course. The knowledge test prospective drivers take at SAAQ service centres is based on the contents of both of these study guides.
